


Overall Project Phasing

- 2023-2024 Phase 2 Utility Improvements -\$6.3 Million
- 2024-2025 North Roadway Reconstruction and Street Light Installation – \$11.6 Million

General Scope of Project and Sequence of Work


- Complete Removal and replacement of existing pavement
- Curb and gutter removal (if existing) and installation of new curb and gutter
- Sidewalk removal and replacement
- Driveway apron removal and replacement
- Parkway restoration (sod)
- Parkway tree plantings
- Decorative Street lighting
- Bartlett Ave. Alley resurfacing
- *Amboy St pavement and curb to remain.



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



Roadway Reconstruction Project Phasing & Construction Schedule



- **Ongoing** Utility relocation work
- June 2024 Tree Removals, All Areas
- June 2024 Tree Root Pruning and Tree Protection Fencing, Stage 1A and 1A
- June-December 2024 Stage 1A & 1B reconstruction. Eastern Ave to receive final HMA surface course. Work is expected to stop over Winter.
- Stage 2 and 3 expected to begin in early spring 2025.
- All roads with exception of Eastern Ave. will receive final HMA surface course in 2025.
- Overall project completion August 2025

 - Eastern Ave (near Vintage Knoll Dr)






Roadway Traffic Calming Improvements

Sidewalk and Sidewalk Ramp Improvements


- New 5' wide sidewalks.




Old Town Neighborhood Improvements

Project Tree Care

- Tree Care Consultant
- Tree Protection Fencing
- Tree Root Pruning
- Tree Trimming
- Tree protection deficiency deduction (\$250 per occurrence, replacement if irreparable damage)



FENCE TO BE PLACED SURROUDNING ALL TREES TO REMAIN. REPRESENTIVE LOCATIONS ARE SHOWN ON EROSION CONTROL PLANS, FINAL LOCATIONS TO BE DETERMINED IN THE FIELD BY THE ENGINEER AND APPROVED BY THE VILLAGE FORESTRY REPRESENTATIVE PRIOR TO PLACING FENCING.



What to Expect

- Work Hours
 - M-F: 7 am 7:30 pm
 - Saturdays: 7 am 5:30 pm (If needed)
- General nature of work
 - Noise
 - Dust
 - Impacts to traffic, parkways, and driveway access



What to Expect

- Traffic Impacts
 - Eastbound Lockport St. detour
 - Unloading/Loading of trucks
 - Traffic flagged around work zone and equipment
 - Short term, daytime road closures
 - Please be patient
- School Bus Stops and Routes



Roadway and Driveway Access

- Roadway Access
 - Temporary day time road closures
 - Roads will be open outside of construction hours
- Driveway Access
 - Temporary restrictions
 - Stone ramps
 - Advanced Notices will be provided

Parking

- Parking Guidelines
 - Generally, there will no parking on streets under construction unless directed otherwise
 - Park legally (vehicle facing correct direction and do not block fire hydrants)




Mail and Garbage

- Mail Delivery
 - Should continue as normal, however use of post office recommended for critical mailings
- Refuse Pickup
 - Put on curbside by 6 am (residential)
 - Currently no changes anticipated to commercial pickups
 - Please advise PW should pickup be missed



Notifications and Correspondence

- Direct email updates
- On Site Presence, Door-to-Door
- Notices / Flyers
- E-News Updates / Village Website
- Available by phone and email
- All resident correspondence should be directed to Resident Engineer (Kevin) and not the contractor's crews.



Resident Responsibilities

- Provide any concerns, questions, comments
- Please mark all private utilities in the parkway
 - Sprinklers
 - Electrical (pet fences, wires)
 - Miscellaneous
- Relocate private possessions from parkway areas (decorations, plantings)



General Safety Considerations

- Exercise Caution Driving Through Site
 - Follow signs
 - Please drive slow for the safety of workers and other residents
 - Keep back from equipment
 - No cell phone use
- Exercise Caution Walking Through Site
 - Watch for uneven surfaces
 - Keep back from excavations
 - Keep away from equipment
